

## How to use this Finale file:

This is an empty Finale file with Human Playback Preferences for the SYNCHRON-ized Special Editions attached. It does not work with other Vienna Instruments or Synchron collections. These settings will take care of keyswitches automatically, when you change articulations.

1.)

In Finale load the file "HPP\_SYzdSE.musx". Go to the MIDI/Audio/Human Playback/Human Playback Preferences menu and uncheck the "Attach to file" option. When prompted, agree to make a copy. The preferences should now be available on the list for all future documents.

2.)

**Windows:** To activate Vienna Ensemble in Finale go to MIDI/Audio/Device Setup/Manage VST Plug-ins and add the Plug-in directory, where your Vienna Ensemble VST plugin (Vienna Ensemble x64.dll) is located. Then in MIDI/Audio/VST Banks & Effects choose Vienna Ensemble. The Vienna Ensemble window, where you can load Synchron Player and your instruments, will open automatically. Also make sure that in the MIDI/Audio menu "Play Finale through VST" is activated.

**Mac:** In MIDI/Audio/Instrument Setup/Audio Units Banks & Effects choose Vienna Ensemble. The Vienna Ensemble window, where you can load Synchron Player and your instruments, will open automatically. Also make sure that in the MIDI/Audio menu "Play Finale through Audio Units" is activated.

3.)

Open the Vienna Ensemble window, make the same channel settings as in the Finale Score Manager and load the Synchron Player presets of the instruments from your score.
